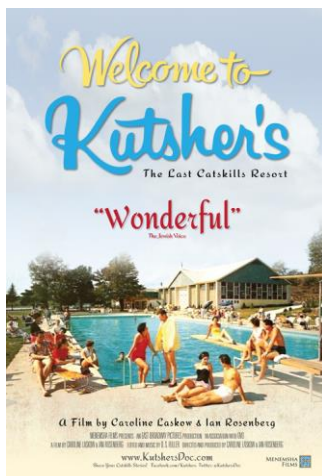


WELCOME TO KUTSHER'S: The Last Catskills Resort

Kutsher's Country Club was the last surviving Jewish resort in the Catskills. One of the legendary Borscht Belt hotels during its heyday, Kutsher's was family-owned and operated for over 100 years, until its sale and demolition in 2014. Exploring the full *Dirty Dancing*-era Catskills experience through a close up look at Kutsher's rise and fall, this award-winning film captures a last glimpse of a lost world as it disappears before our eyes.
